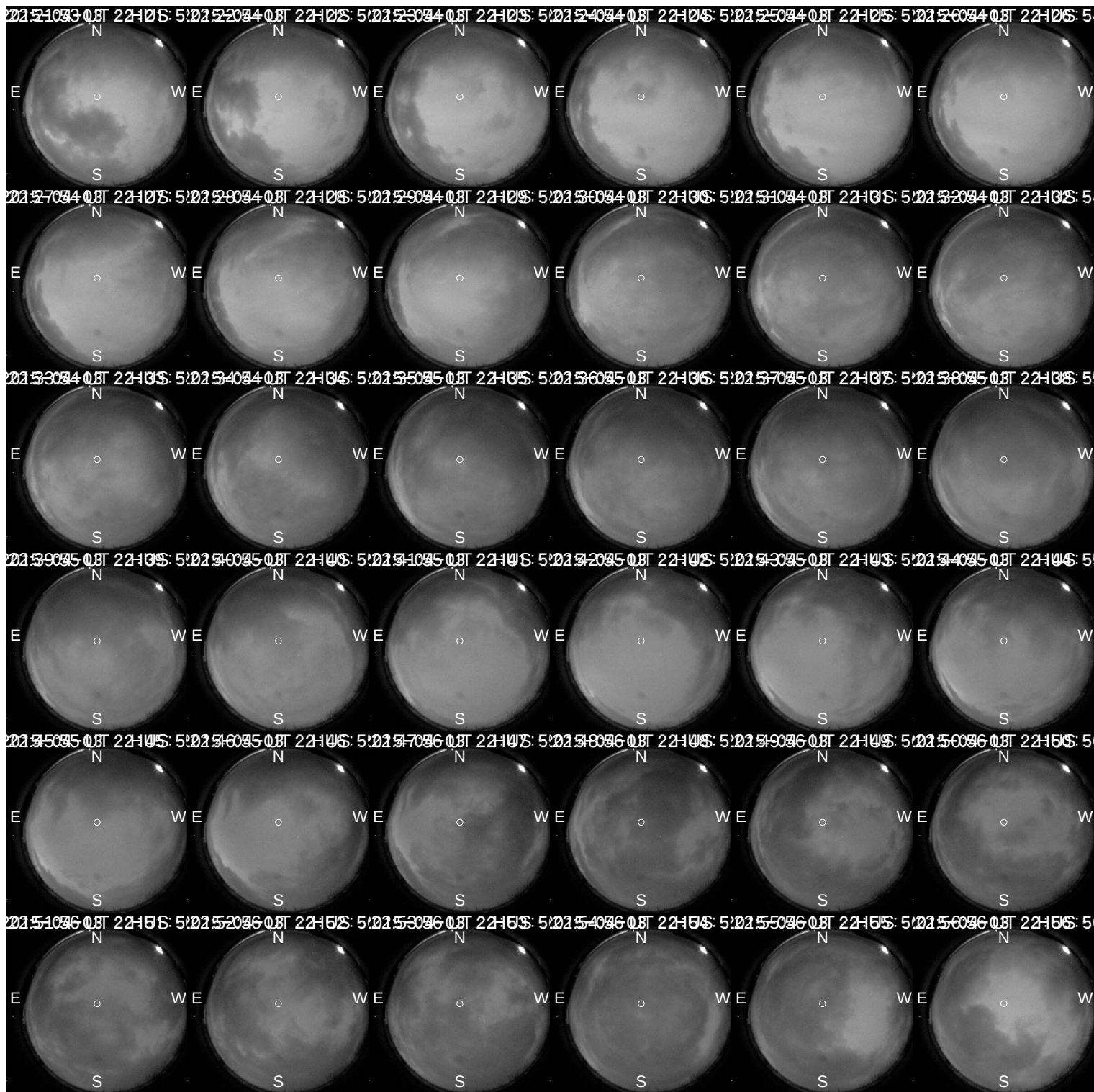


Husafell Watec All-Sky Images 20150403–20150404



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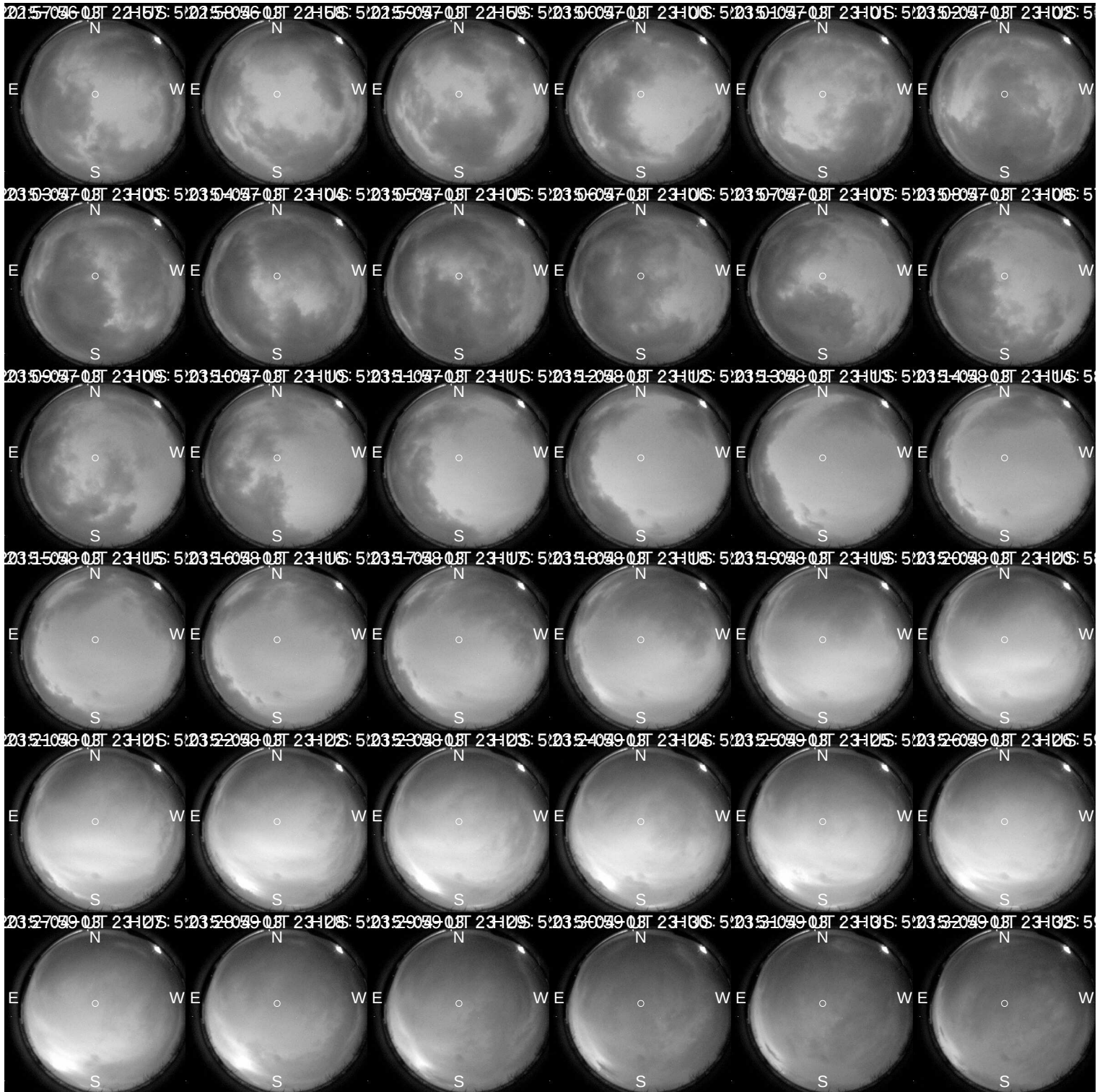
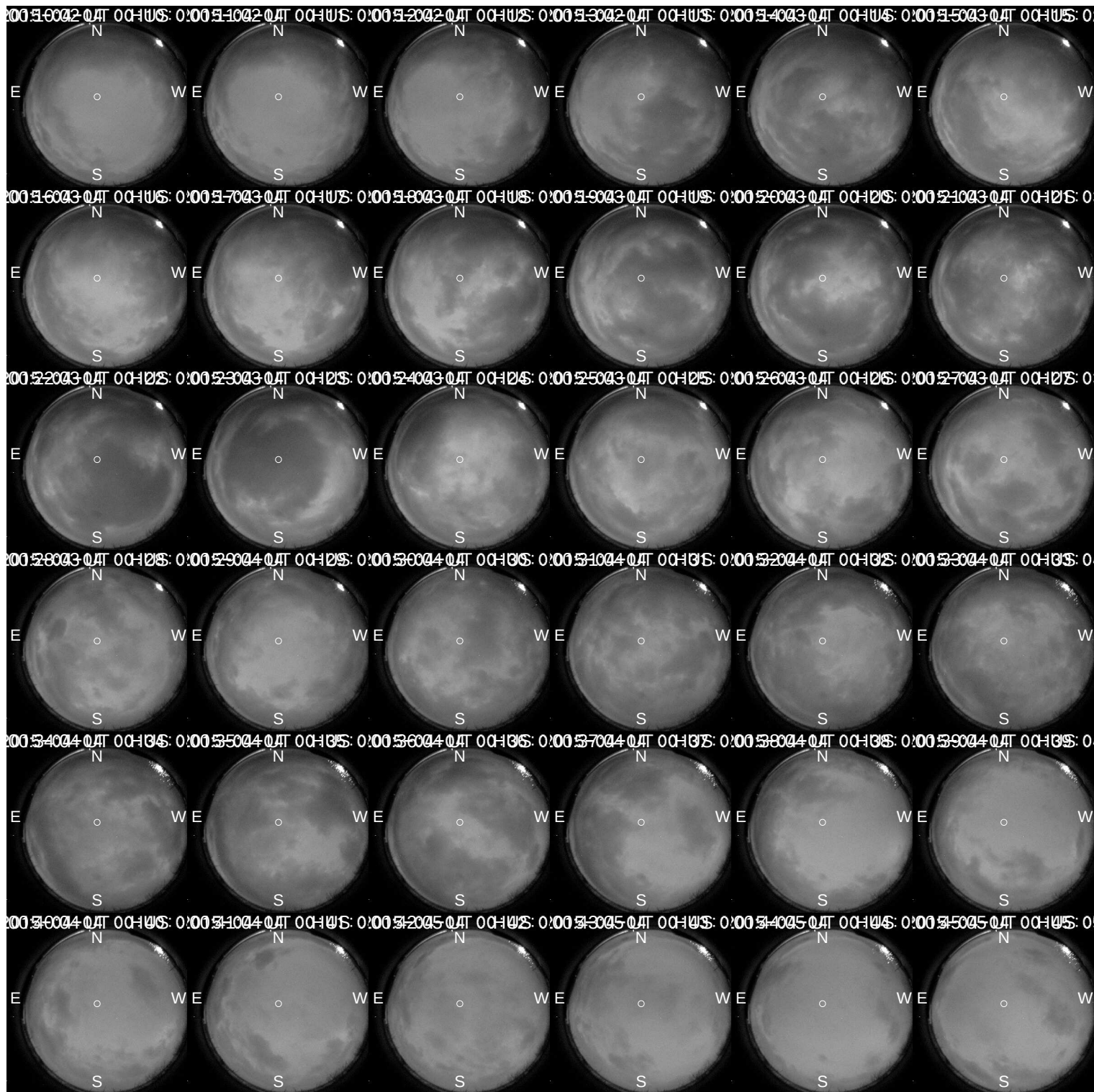
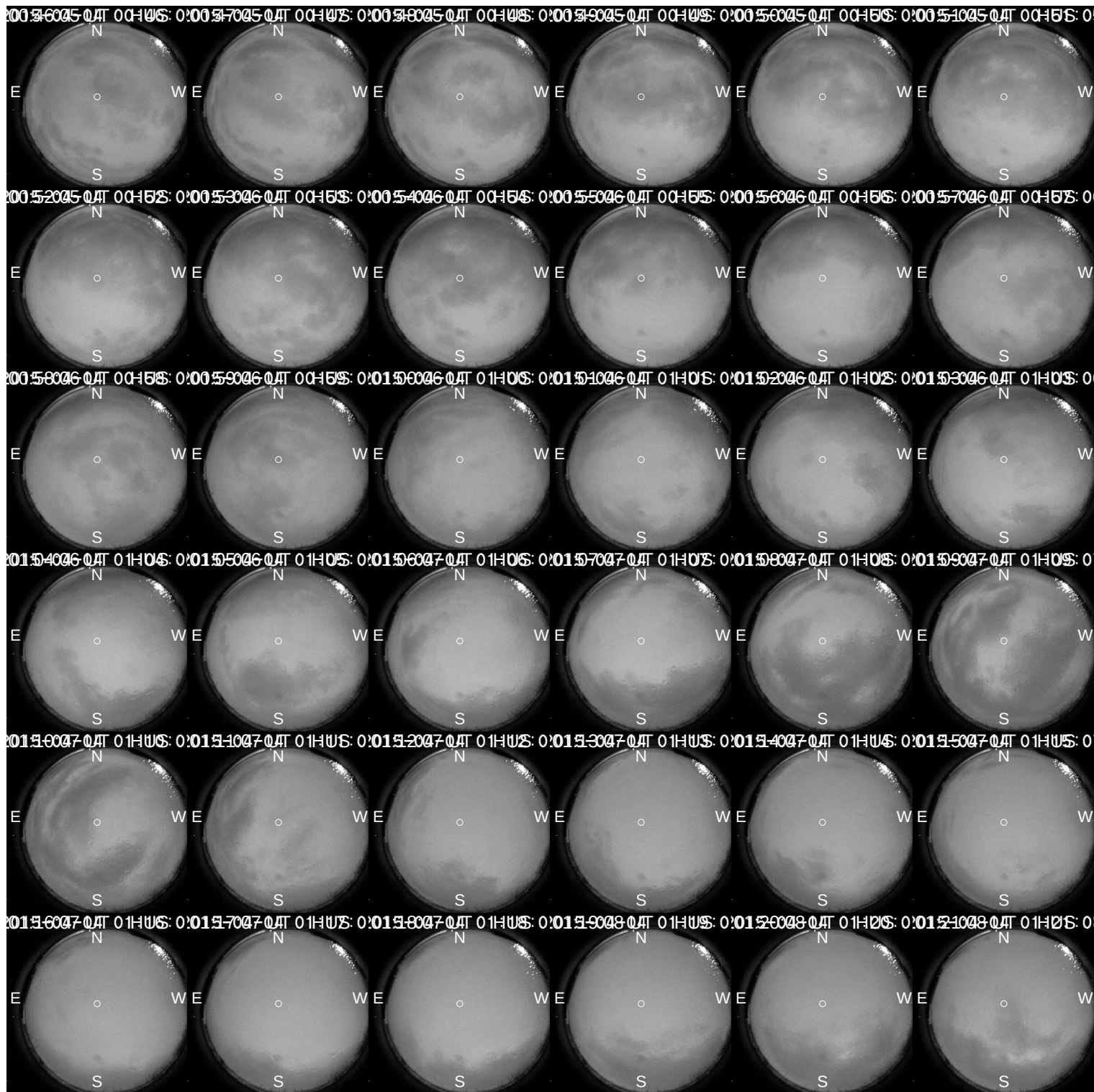
